Midstate Electric Scholarship Program – Continuing Education

Purpose: Midstate Electric Cooperative (MEC) offers \$2,500 scholarships for continuing education. These scholarships are available to members who have already graduated high school and are seeking to continue their education.

Application: Visit https://www.midstateelectric.coop/scholarship-programs for an application.

Requirements:

Scholastic - Applicant must meet the entrance requirements of the elected school before applying for MEC's scholarship.

Residence - The primary residence of the applicant or parent/guardian of the applicant must be in MEC's service area.

College/Trade School - Any accredited college/trade school is acceptable to qualify for MEC's scholarship.

Qualifying Activities - To include, but not be limited to scholastic achievement, future goals, and application presentation.

Application Presentation – Application and attached documentation are <u>neat, typed and grammatically correct</u>.

Award - Scholarship awards will be sent directly to the college/trade school on behalf of the recipient. Funds must be used for tuition, books, and curriculum related expenses. If the recipient of the scholarship terminates the program of study prior to the end of the funding period, the college/trade school will refund the remaining unused portion of the scholarship back to MEC.

Duration - MEC's continuing education scholarship is a one-year scholarship. Each recipient may re-apply for an additional year but must go through the application and selection process again.
