Midstate members can pay for electricity before it's used and then use the electricity until the credit expires. PowerPay members choose how they are notified when their balance is running low. Members can receive notifications via email, automated calling service or text message.

We also offer energy-efficiency programs to save you money and energy. Rebates are

available on Energy Star appliances, heat pumps, heat pump water heaters, duct sealing, windows, weatherization and manufactured homes. You may also call us for an energy



audit and tips for installing energy-saving measures.

The most important investment we make is in our local youth. MEC demonstrates its commitment to youth through initiatives such as our scholarship program, Youth Tour and MEC Career Day.

In 2023, we proudly awarded \$53,750 in scholarships to deserving local students through our scholarship program. Our Youth Tour Program annually sends high school sophomores and juniors to Washington, D.C., for an immersive weeklong experience, providing them with firsthand exposure to democracy in action. During Career Day, local high school students gain insights into the exciting opportunities within our industry.
